Hearing for Edward and Vicky Lilla regarding compulsory connection to Village sewer.

Attorney Linda Gray explained the Village Ordinance which gives the ability to come to the Board.

Attorney Richard Torhorst explained his clients Edward and Vicki Lilla are claiming Economic Hardship.

Attorney Torhorst called their first witness Rich Dorgay; Walworth County Code Officer.

Attorney Torhorst listed Exhibit #1 County permit for Lilla.

Attorney Torhorst called their second witness Edward Lilla.

Attorney Torhorst called their third witness Todd Schiller; Village of Genoa City Public Works Superintendent.

Attorney Torhorst listed Exhibit #2 copy of map showing manholes, sheets 3-12 Hunter Ridge Subdivision dated March 13, 2001.

Attorney Torhorst listed Exhibit #3 a view of manhole #22 with large circle, east, or right footmark 66ft and location of Lilla's parcel.

Attorney Linda Gray called the Village's first witness John Wrzeszcz former Village of Genoa City Public Works Superintendent.

Attorney Gray called second witness Brandon Foss Village of Genoa City Engineer; Crispell-Snyder.

Attorney Gray called third witness Todd Schiller.

Closing Arguments were heard.

Discussion and possible action regarding compulsory connection to Village sewer for Edward and Vicky Lilla.

After much discussion on an Antti/Parker motion to deny the Hardship it was not proven; not carried 2-3 (Boxer, Hunt, and Traskaski)

On a Traskaski/Hunt motion to Allow Lilla's not to hook up to Village sewer until their septic fails; carried 3-2 (Antti and Parker)

On a Traskaski/Parker motion to adjourn; carried 5-0.
