**New Business:** **Public Hearing on the possible conditional use filed by Vince and Heather Siegel DBA American Fireworks and Novelties LLC to sale 1.4g consumer grade fireworks from outside a Canopy Tent from June 10<sup>th</sup> until July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2010 on the following described property 219 State Route 12.**

Motion made by Sherman/Antti to open Public Hearing on the possible conditional use filed by Vince and Heather Siegel DBA American Fireworks and Novelties LLC to sale 1.4g consumer grade fireworks from outside a Canopy Tent from June 10<sup>th</sup> until July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2010 on the following described property 219 State Route 12; carried 3-0.

Heather Siegel explained the conditional use filed by American Fireworks LLC. She stated it would be the same set up as last year.

Vince Siegel spoke on behalf of American Fireworks LLC that they hire college kids that depend on this job for money. He asked the board to grant the conditional use because he sells novelty fireworks. If Genoa City does not have the tents Residents are more apt to get bigger fireworks elsewhere. Residents that like fireworks will seek them out.

Phil Traskaski stated he talked to the Chief and the Chief had no issues or traffic problems with American Fireworks LLC.
